For main fabric choose a bright juvenile print of any color. Select two coordinating fabrics for the other two fabrics. Make these bright, fun and happy that will please a young child. The quilt can be made for a child who is a family member or to donate to one of our charities. Have fun with this simple block.

Cut a 6 1/2" square from the main print
Cut two $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and cut diagonally for four half- square triangles from 2nd fabric
From 3rd fabric (this will be the background) cut two $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and cut diagonally
for four half-square triangles and cut four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
Make four "half-square units from the two coordinating


Fabrics then assemble block as shown above.
Note: Since we started our blocks in February, which would cause us to have to go over into January of 2015 to finish our 12 blocks, I would like to do two blocks this month so that we will be able finish the twelfth block and have our drawing in December. Make the second block in black and white (black on white, white on black). Choose any combination of the black and white prints. Just be sure there is plenty of contrast in the in the three fabric choices. This is such a simple block so I don't think it will be too much work for one month. Thank you for bearing with me on this.
