## 12 1/2" (12" finished)



Fabrics: Reproductions (Civil War/1800s)
Main Print (Medium/Dark): Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, two $47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and cut once diagonally for 4 half-square triangles and cut four 2 1/2" squares

Medium light: Cut four 2 1/2" squares


Light (background): Cut two $47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and cut once diagonally for four half-square triangles,
and cut eight 2 1/2" squares


Assembly: Stitch the main print triangles to the light triangles to make four half-square units. Make 4-patch units from the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares as shown above, paying close attention to the placement of the 3 fabrics as you stitch the blocks together. This is important to make the blocks spin correctly. I have included a diagram of the blocks stitched block to block which makes a very interesting pattern.
