January—Modern Pinwheel (12-1/2" finished block)

Fabrics: Two modern prints, 2 coordinating solids


Print 1: Cut a 3" center square
Print 2: $\quad$ Cut two 6 " squares for half square triangles
Solid 1: Cut four 3" squares
Cut two 6: squares for half-square triangles
Solid 2: $\quad$ Cut four 3 " squares

- To make half square triangles, draw a diagonal line on the back of the two solid squares. Place a solid square and print square right sides together. Stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on either side of the diagonal line.
- Cut along the diagonal line, and press open
- Square the block to make a finished $5-1 / 2$ " square

Assembly: Sew a Solid 1 square to a Solid 2 square to make four units. Sew these units to the center square and half square triangle units as shown.
