June—Chevron Star (12" finished square)


Fabrics: Modern print, white/white tone on tone, four prints or solids that complement the modern print.

Modern Print: $\quad$ Cut one $4-1 / 2$ " square, fussy cut if you want to highlight a print or design

White background: Four 2-1/2" squares
Fourteen 3" squares for half square triangles
Four different assorted
Complementary patterns: At least three 3 " squares from each fabric, and four from two of the fabrics, for a total of 14 squares, for half square triangles

- To make half square triangles, draw a diagonal line on the back of the white squares. Place a white square right sides together with each of the colored squares. Stitch a $1 / 4$ " seam on either side of the diagonal line.
- Cut along the diagonal line, and press open
- Square to 2-1/2"

There will be extra half square triangles for your orphan stash.
Assemble the squares and half square triangles to create each row, then sew rows together.
