September—Rainbow Charm (12" finished square)
Fabrics: Choose four colors, using two shades of each color, for a total of eight fabrics, white or white on white for centers and background.


White: Four 3-1/" squares
Four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, then cut in half along the diagonal to make half square triangles

From each of the remaining fabrics:
One 2" x 5" rectangle
One 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle
One $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, cut in half along the diagonal to make half square triangles (you will only use one triangle from each fabric)

Sew a colored triangle to a white triangle to create half square triangles, square to 2".

Create four units, each one out of a separate color. Two units will be pieced together as shown on the left, the other two will be pieced as shown on the right.
