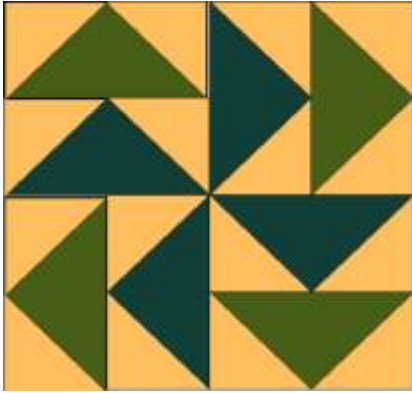


## Flying Geese (12-1/2" unfinished square) August 2016 (Revised)

Make 1 block.



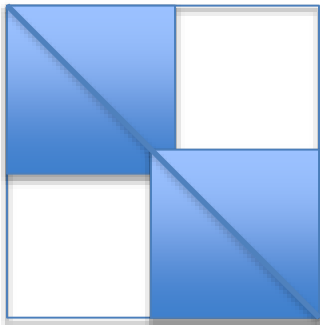
Fabric 1: Cut two (2) 7-1/2 x 7-1/2 squares

Fabric 2: Cut four (4) 3-7/8" squares

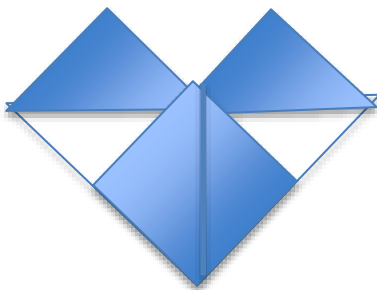
Fabric 3: Cut four (4) 3-7/8" squares

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each smaller square.

Right sides together, place two small squares on one of the larger squares, as shown:



Stitch 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line.  
Cut along the diagonal line, then iron open.



Place another small square on each of the new units, and stitch 1/4" on either side of the diagonal line. Cut along the diagonal line, and open and press to create your flying geese.

Assemble flying gees according to diagram.
