

Supply List for Susan Corbett's Basic Backgrounds Machine Quilting Class

- Your best sewing machine for machine quilting (no Featherweights or similar) that you know how to operate
- Walking (even-feed) foot and hopping (darning) foot
- Machine quilting needles, size 80/12 or 75/11
- Cotton or polyester thread, 50/3 in a slightly contrasting color, so you can see what you're doing. Pre-wind a bobbin or two.
- 1 yard solid color fabric cut along fold line into two pieces, pressed free of wrinkles
- Thread snips
- Removable marking pen/pencil
- Acrylic ruler or other straight edge tool for marking straight lines, 12" or whatever you like
- Cotton, cotton/poly blend or any batting other than high-loft comforter filling, cut to fit your fabric pieces.
- Safety pins for basting
- Instruction manual for your machine
- Paper and pen for note-taking and sketching

Note: The first thing we will do in class is baste, so please refrain from setting up your machine until basting is completed.
