

## Strip Pieced Star Quilt ©

102" x 102"

Designed by Cynthia L. Regone

Block size: 24" finished

No. of blocks: 9

Fabric requirements:

Approximately 6 yards total of assorted lights and 6 yards of brights (Please feel free to use scraps to fulfill these yardage requirements.) The yardage is only an estimate.

3 yards for outside border and binding

9  $\frac{3}{4}$  yards for backing

To make one block you will need the following:

As assortment of light and brights fabrics cut into: 1", 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " and 2" x any length. Scraps are especially useful in this project.

(WHEN CUTTING THE STRIPS, IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO KEEP THEM IN ORDER ACCORDING TO WIDTHS. THE STRIPS WILL BE CHOSEN RANDOMLY AND PUT INTO THE BLOCKS IN NO PARTICULAR ORDER.)

6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler

Long ruler for cutting additional strips if needed

Rotary cutter/mat

Pencil

Iron/ portable ironing surface

Wooden presser used when paper piecing

Sewing machine (must know how to adjust stitch length on your machine)

Basic sewing supplies

Description of class: The 24" block is divided into 16 sections. Each section is sewn on a paper foundation. The paper is used only as a foundation and will be removed after the entire block is sewn together.

Bring additional fabric to class as it is hard to estimate just how much fabric will be needed to make one block.

Kit fee: \$35 which includes pattern,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " marking tool, 144 (6  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") foundation papers and 15 sheets of Spinning Star papers to make the half-square triangles for the inner border.
