

SILHOUETTE WORKSHOP

Class Description:

In the Silhouette class, you will use 2 fat quarters to create your portrait. There are up to 30 different patterns to choose from, ranging from people, animals, flowers, and sea creatures. You will be given a list of the subjects before the class, so that you can preselect your fat quarters and determine which pattern you want to do before class (needing 1 light and 1 dark fat quarters).

Supplies for Silhouette Class:

1. Ink pen or Finepoint Sharpie
2. 4" pointed-tip embroidery or applique scissors. (I use the ones with a curved tip, Kai N5000 Series.)
3. Straight pins or applique pins (These are shorter pins. If your local quilt shop does not have them, Hobby Lobby has some. They are sequin pins.)
4. 3-4 Gradated Fat Quarters .(Just so that you have a variety.) You will basically need one light fabric and one dark fabric. You can use a fabric with print, but just make sure that it reads as a solid from at least 3 feet away. Also, be careful mixing two batiks if the print on them is busy.
5. 1/2 yard of Heat N Bond Lite or Feather Weight. (I prefer the Heat N Bond Lite because it is easier to sew through when quilting.)
6. Small piece of foam core board that will accommodate the size of a fat quarter (pattern for class is roughly an 11x14).
