Sharon Ligon

Sharon has selected a spool block for this year. There are 2 options for making it—it can be a single color for the thread/main part of the block, or you can use some of your strips to create a strip-pieced thread section.

Cutting:

Light Tan/Off White: Cut four (4) 1-1/2" squares

Cut two (2) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

Brown: Cut two (2) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip

Single Color: Cut one (1) 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle

If doing multiple color, cut 4 fabrics into 1-1/2" x 4" strips

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each of the $1 \cdot 1/2$ " squares.
- 2. Place a square on each end of the brown strip, as shown.




3. Stitch on the diagonal line. Repeat with the other brown strip and off white squares. Press the squares open and trim.

4. If making a strip set, sew your strips together using a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam along the long sides. Trim down to a $3 \cdot 1/2$ " x $4 \cdot 1/2$ " rectangle.



5. Stitch the tan background strips to the long side of the strip set or your solid rectangle. Add the top and bottom strips.

Dear Friends: Summer is almost here and we should have lots of free time to sew. I am looking forward to it. Your donations have been delivered to Project Linus and are ready for distribution to the kids in hospitals if they aren't already in the arms of a precious child.

In the event I have not included your name in the thanks please forgive and let me know.

Project Linus meets the second and fourth Thursdays at Southcliff BaptistChurch in Fort Worth. We bring our machines and sewing notions and sew all day. We bring our lunches, there is a soda machine. We sew together the quilt sandwiches and some even make the three piece sandwiches. We attach labels to the quilts and share our creations. It is always a very busy day making quilts for the kids. It requires a lot of sewing to deliver an average of 300 quilts a month and then we also deliver to Snowball Express in the fall for children of a deceased active duty military.

The hospitals request measurements that will conform to most of the children and we try to accommodate them:

For younger patients 44 x 40 is a good size

For larger kids and there are a lot of them 57 x 40 is usually big enough.

Remember the work we do for our guild and our community enriches us and the generations to come.
