History of the QGOA Special Award Ribbons

Spirit of Arlington

To boost our community and city government involvement with our annual QGOA Quilt Festival the quilt committee would arrange someone to come to our show and choose a quilt they felt exhibited the "Spirit of Arlington". We would start contacting the mayor and sometimes one would come or assign someone from their office, of course at the last minute, to replace them. We would have city council members, or chairpersons of various charity or art organizations. It was a well-meaning attempt for outreach, but no one was really happy about who was chosen, or who finally showed up to do the judging. Most importantly the people involved knew nothing about quilting and no one was happy with their choices!

Ouida Bost Award

Ouida Bost was a founding member of our guild and an amazing quilter and hand quilter. She felt that with the quilting world moving to machine quilting that those few remaining hand quilters were not getting the recognition they deserved. With the quilt committee in agreement, she and her daughters, (also fantastic hand quilters) would choose the outstanding hand quilted quilt in the Festival. When Ouida passed, a decision was made to honor her by establishing an award ribbon in her name to recognize a quilt with exemplary workmanship. The NTQF Festival had added ribbon awards for hand and machine quilting so the hand quilters had an opportunity to be awarded and celebrate.

Past Presidents Award

The QGOA past presidents would gather to select a quilt to receive an award that they all felt exemplified all the quality aspects of quilting.

North Texas Quilt Festival (NTQF)

When the consolidation of the local guild quilt shows occurred, QGOA joined the NTQF at the Original Sewing and Quilt Expo. The QGOA show committee wanted to continue the recognition of our guild member quilts in the Festival. With the approval of the NTQF show committee QGOA would be able to add two ribbons for QGOA winning quilts in the judged festival. Conditions included to have ribbons of similar size as the show ribbons. Since Ouida had passed, and it was no longer an Arlington quilt show, the QGOA show committee decided to use the past guild presidents to judge and determine the winners of the two award ribbons: Spirit of Arlington Award for Exemplary Creativity and the Ouida Bost Award for Exemplary Workmanship.






