This Quilt Along is taken from the same book as the last two quilt alongs, and is great for using up scraps. The book is [Vintage Christmas by Lori Holt](#). Every block in this book is offered as a 6" and 12". Combining the 6" blocks would make an amazing mini quilt. Having the book will allow you to work ahead if you choose and have open time in your sewing schedule. We should finish this one up just in time to be able to show them at the Guild's Trunk Show of Christmas/Winter Quilts at our December, 2023 meeting.

The Quilt Along starts on **April 9, 2023**, and should finish around September 24, 2023, sooner for those of you doing 12 inch blocks. I will send out 2 blocks a week. Those doing the 6" blocks will do both and those doing the 12" blocks will pick their favorites and stop when they have 25 blocks. All of the blocks in the book will be done for the 6" quilt setting.

I have provided pictures of 2 options for this quilt along, but there is a third setting option using both 6" and 12" blocks in the book (page 192). This would allow you to do the harder blocks as 12" and the easier ones as 6". You would just need to add 2 blocks of your choice for the mixed setting, but that would be more scraps used up.

- Option #1 has 42 - 6" finished blocks and the quilt measures 66.5" x 74.5"



- Option #2 has 25 - 12" finished blocks and measures 90.5" x 90.5"



- Option #3 has 12 - 12" and 32 - 6" finished blocks and measures 70.5" x 88.5" (page 192)

You could use any setting in this book to make this work for you. There are several to choose from.

OK, I know that is a lot of information to digest. You can ask me questions at Guild Meetings, or via email/phone/text. I hope many of you will join in sewing this adorable quilt. **If you want to join the quilt along this round please email me** (my email is in the directory) and let me know.
